Seeking to modernize an existing admissions building, Tri-State University selected Irmscher, Inc. to perform a 7,000-sq. ft. renovation of Forman Hall, a 1930s era brick structure. Upon commencement of the project, Irmscher, Inc. was challenged to design and construct additional student interview rooms that would blend with the current building.

In order to ensure a thorough and accurate design/build process, Irmscher, Inc. worked closely with the interior designer to maintain budget and schedule constraints. Creating an air of elegance, various elaborate and unusual materials were incorporated into the Forman Hall Welcome Center, including a marble fireplace imported from China, Waterford crystal light fixtures, rich mahogany woodwork, and Botticino marble flooring.

Accented by beautiful landscaping and mature trees, Tri-State University's Forman Hall now serves as a welcome center for prospective new students, including new offices for the registrar, admissions, and financial aid.
